

Free school meals

Your child may also be eligible for free school meals if you receive certain benefits. Please follow this link to find out more or to register for free school meals. Once an application has been approved, your child will then be entitled to receive a lunchtime meal from our meal provider.

Pupil Premium

If your child is eligible for free school meals and you register them for this, we will receive extra funding called 'pupil premium.' Pupil Premium funding is used to help parents with things such as the cost of uniform (up to £100 annually), support towards school trips, including residential trips, music lessons and holiday club provision.
